

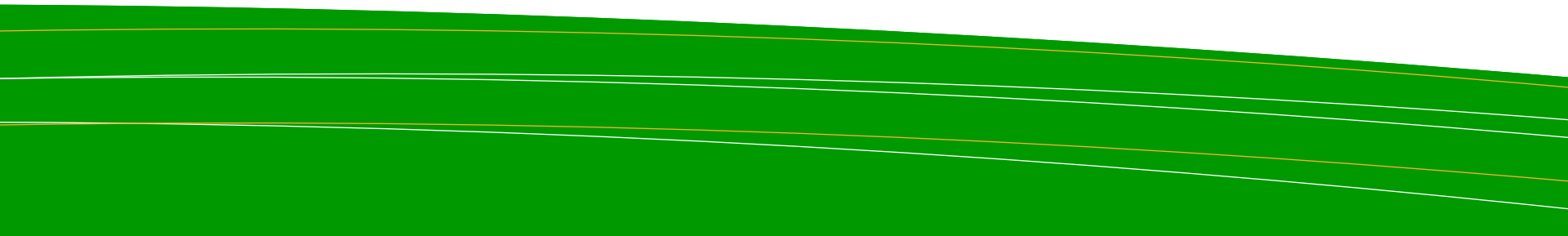

Our Logo

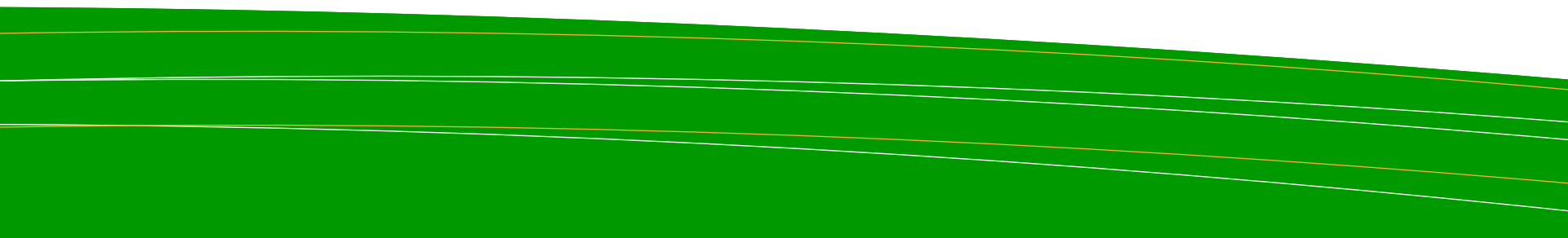


- The logo has been designed this year and features key elements of the village.

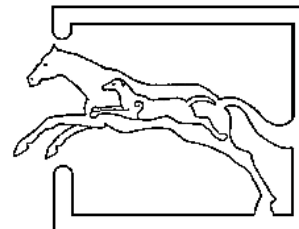

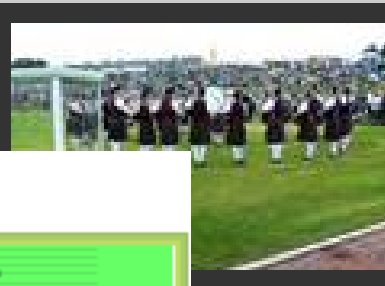

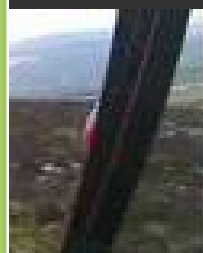
